# **MLFN Participation**

The School Food Development Project is a collaboration between the UofS, MLTC Education and Saskatoon Public Schools to determine what an ideal school food program would look like for your community. Participation is voluntary. To learn more about school food programing we will invite participants to complete some surveys, and interviews to collect feedback from staff, community members and students.

To date initial staff interviews have been conducted in 7 of 9 Meadow Lake First Nations (MLFNs) with more anticipated this fall: MLCN, MSFN, FDFN, ERDN, CRDN, BRDN, BNDN.

Staff in 8 of 9 participating schools have been invited to complete an online staff survey in June and we renew our invitation to those who have not yet done so. Please share this newsletter and the QR code!

Next steps include sharing information about the project through the promo video and gaining community feedback through the community online survey at community gatherings and events, and finalizing a student survey.
